What is the Difference Between a Story Topic and Theme?

TOPIC - IS THE <u>BIG BOX</u>

Example:

I want to write a story about COURAGE. Courage is my BIG BOX.

I will label it 'COURAGE'.

COURAGE

THEME: THE UNDERLYING MESSAGE IN MY STORY

Remember

Courage is my topic. My BIG BOX.
Theme is the message I put inside my BIG BOX.

Example:

 "Acknowledging and learning from your mistakes makes you a courageous person."

This is the message I want my reader to take from my writing.



MORE THAN ONE THEME

Remember

• If courage is the BIG BOX, you can choose to tell your story engaging more than one theme.

Example:

• My story is about the character learning to accept his/her mistakes, but in order to be brave enough to do that, they come across friends who support them to achieve this goal. So, my story is also about friendship.

The topic you choose can have shared themes and messages.


